Wheadon's Rock Samphire & Pink Grapefruit. Guernsey

Pink grapefruit at the fore with a juniper and cassia core. A deep structure with gentle green marine nuances and layered top notes of grapefruit and citrus.

Paired with Fever Tree classic tonic & garnished with grapefruit peel.

Gin Mare

Barcelona, Spain

Bold tones of rosemary, thyme, olive & basil included in the botanical line-up this gin is unusually savoury but very well balanced.

Paired with Fever Tree Mediterranean tonic & garnished with rosemary sprig & olive

## **Martin Millers**

England/Iceland

Blended with Icelandic spring water, juniper notes dominate on the palate & a richer, spicier mouthfeel ends with a gentle finish.

Paired with Fever Tree light tonic & garnished with pepper & strawberry

### The Botanist

Islay, Scotland

Created by the Bruichladdich Distillery, a blend of 9 botanicals from around the world & a further 22 botanicals from the hills, bogs, & shore of Islay.

Paired with Fever Tree elderflower tonic & garnished with fresh thyme & lemon.

### **Pink Pepper**

Cognac, France

Fresher spicy notes of pink pepper, juniper and cardamom are prominent it evolves and warms up allowing notes of vanilla, tonka and honey to shine through.

Paired with Fever Tree aromatic tonic & garnished with peppercorns.

#### **Brockmans**

London, England

A fruity gin incorporating juniper, coriander, wild berries and citrus. Paired with Fever Tree ginger ale & garnished with fresh blueberries.

### **Adnams Copper House**

Southwold, England

Made with orris root, coriander seed & cardamon pods this gin finishes with rich floral hibiscus & citrus peel.

Paired with Fever Tree Mediterranean tonic & garnished with orange flamed peel.

### Monkey 47

**Black Forest, Germany** 

Even though there are 47 botanicals, citrus & lingonberries are prevalent to taste, closely joined by pine, spruce & herbal notes.

Paired with Fever Tree classic tonic & garnished with mint leaf.
